

RESERVATIONS & CHECK-IN

Rates: \$175 per week day/ \$200 weekends
Deposit: One night stay
Two night minimum
Maximum of 7 people

Call Storybook Theatre at 808-335-0712 and leave a message regarding reservations and your call will be returned promptly. 100% of deposit for extra cleaning or damage is required upon reservation. Minimum age for cabin rental is 25. Registered guests must also stay in the cabin and are responsible for the condition of cabin upon check-out.

Check-in and key pick up at Storybook Theatre of Hawaii, 3814 Hanapepe Road, Hanapepe, HI, located just off the Kaunualii Highway 50. If coming from the east, take a right at the Hanapepe Fire Station, then at stop sign take another right. Storybook Theatre is the red building on the right side.

Valid ID and full payment for rental are required at check-in. You may check in and get your key in Hanapepe anytime after 9AM on your day of rental. Your cabin will be available by 4PM, giving you and your family time to explore the park while we are able to ensure the cabin is ready for your arrival.

Check out time is 11AM. Please call for key drop off in Hanapepe by 5PM.

DIRECTIONS

From Waimea town Highway 50 headed west, take a right onto Highway 550 up to Koke'e State Park. At mile marker 13, take a left onto dirt road. Veer towards the right and take a left at the fork, drive down past two cabins and turn right into driveway with gold metal chain gate. Unlock the gate and carefully pull in front of the A-frame cabin to unload. It can be muddy, AWD or 4x4 vehicles required. Please park under the pine trees off of the grass after unloading.

CONDITIONS

***Please remember in order to get your deposit back, the following should be done and rules followed:

- No animals, smoking, alcohol, or open fires
- Keep noise levels reasonable
- Respect maximum capacity
- All trash is taken off of the grounds upon departure
- Empty refrigerator, microwave, oven, and cupboards of any food items
- Wipe surfaces in bathroom and kitchen (including appliances)
- Remove all personal belongings (including towels and linens)
- Sweep floors and porch
- Clean out ashes in fireplace (place in metal bin outside of cabin)
- Turn off all lights and close windows and curtains when locking up
- Turn the gas off at the tank
- Be sure to pull the driveway gate chain around the pole and lock it chain to chain

CABIN AMENITIES

This is a one bedroom, one bath A-frame cabin with a loft. There are two twin beds in the bedroom and three futons provided for the loft. The couch in the living room can pull out into a bed as well. Kitchen is fully equipped with stove top/oven, refrigerator, microwave, Brita water filter, rice maker, and coffeemaker. A full set of utensils, dinnerware, and cookware are provided. The bathroom features a tub and shower. Paper towels and toilet paper are provided. Firewood is also available for the wood-burning stove in the cabin.

Please note that there is no WiFi or cell phone service. There is a pay phone at the Kokee lodge further up the main road. Waimea town has emergency services and supplies. Water or electricity may go out depending on the weather and the trees in the area so please be prepared with extra water and flashlights.

WHAT TO BRING

At this time we are taking extra precautions to keep our cabin clean and sanitary for the safety of our guests and staff. Please bring your own towels, linens, blankets, and pillows, this includes any dish towels or rags you think you may need. It can be muddy so be prepared with extra towels or mats. Also be sure to bring any condiments you may wish to use for cooking. A water filter is provided but we recommend bringing your own drinking water.
